This show is open to all dairy calf club members 9-13 years of age, as of January 1, 2023, who are registered as 4-H members in the counties of East-Central Ontario Holstein District. This show is designed as an educational and fun event. Our goal is to make the activities hands on and practical.

1. Calves, 4-H'ers and chaperones to arrive at the Orono Fairgrounds **between 12:00 and 1:00 p.m.** on Wednesday, July 5th
2. Calf must be the 2023 calf project of the 4-H member. Substitutes allowed if calf is sick, please let organizers know ASAP.
3. CALVES **MUST BE CLIPPED** EXCEPT FOR THE TOPLINE PRIOR TO ARRIVAL AT THE FAIRGROUNDS. The organizing committee will have fitters available to assist the contestants to complete the topline of the calf.
4. 4-H members will have stall cards provided to identify the calf and 4-H member.
5. All calves must be dual tagged (button and panel) with dairy approved tags.
6. Full Whites and appropriate footwear are required for showmanship and conformation classes. T-shirts will be provided for participants.
7. Straw will be provided by the committee.
8. Meals will be provided for all contestants and chaperones.
9. Health, Medical and Participant agreements are now part of your online registration.
