This show is open to all dairy calf club members 9-13 years of age, as of January 1, 2023, who are registered as 4-H members in the counties of East-Central Ontario Holstein District. This show is designed as an educational and fun event. Our goal is to make the activities hands on and practical.

- 1. Calves, 4-H'ers and chaperones to arrive at the Orono Fairgrounds **between 12:00 and 1:00 p.m**. on Wednesday, July 5th
- 2. Calf must be the 2023 calf project of the 4-H member. Substitutes allowed if calf is sick, please let organizers know ASAP.
- CALVES <u>MUST BE CLIPPED</u> EXCEPT FOR THE TOPLINE PRIOR TO ARRIVAL AT THE FAIRGROUNDS. The organizing committee will have fitters available to assist the contestants to complete the topline of the calf.
- 4. 4-H members will have stall cards provided to identify the calf and 4-H member.
- 5. All calves must be dual tagged (button and panel) with dairy approved tags.
- 6. Full Whites and appropriate footwear are required for showmanship and conformation classes. T-shirts will be provided for participants.
- 7. Straw will be provided by the committee.
- 8. Meals will be provided for all contestants and chaperones.
- 9. Health, Medical and Participant agreements are now part of your online registration.
- 10. All leaders, chaperones, parents and volunteers must abide by Ontario 4-H Council Board Policies, which can be viewed at https://4-hontario.ca/wp-content/uploads/2020/07/2022-Policy-Manual-Master-May.pdf
